Mini Horse Open High Point Champion & Reserve Champion for Day – All classes count – Belt Buckles & Trophies**
High Point Championships awarded to Overall high point mini/exhibitor combo. Special High Point driving award presented high point overall driver/horse combo.

*** Fun Classes & Pee Wee Classes - \$4.00**

RULES:

1. **All equine participants including lead line must sign waiver to ride. Under 18, must be signed by guardian or parent.**
2. Rules & regulations by AQHA & 4-H State Rules unless otherwise specified. No horse can enter same class more than once.
3. Current negative coggins required to show. Will be checked with entry.
4. Pony Classification - under 14.2 & under hands and rider 18 years & under (unless specified) as of January 1, 2009; youth classification - 18 & under as of January 1.
5. Pee Wee classes - rider – 9-11 as of January 1, 2009; attire informal.
6. Western tack mandatory for western classes and hunter tack mandatory for hunter classes; protective headgear required in speed for rider's safety.
7. Stallions cannot be shown by anyone under 18.
8. Judges decision final; **Less than 4 entries - no class except PeeWee; classes can be combined, changed or canceled by show management.**
9. All dogs on leashes.
10. Horses must stay in horse area of park. No fast riding around ring or parked vehicles.
11. No alcoholic beverages, profanity or unsportsmanlike conduct; will be asked to leave.
12. The club or ground owners will not be held responsible for accidents or injuries to persons, animals, or on grounds.
13. Participants are encouraged to throw trash in proper receptacles. Aluminum cans in recyclable containers.
14. Entry fees will not be refunded for a class once that class has started. If you need to scratch a class, you must do so 2 classes prior to that class. If you do not scratch 2 classes ahead, you will be charged for the class whether you show or not. Tack changes will be 3 minutes, need to be requested at booth 1 class ahead.
15. Two way ties for champion & reserve may be broken by hack off unless both riders agree to coin toss. Rider not being available, tie will go to other.
16. Return check charge will be \$25.00.
17. Point tabulations will be by entries in classes: (6 entries: {1st – 6 pts; 2nd – 5pts; 3rd-4pts; 4th – 3pts; 5th – 2pts; 6th – 1 pt.}); (5 entries: {1st – 5 pts; 2nd – 4pts; 3rd – 3 pts.; 4th – 2 pts; 5th – 1 pt}); (4 entries: {1st – 4 pts; 2nd – 3 pts; 3rd – 2 pts; 4th – 1 pt}); (3 entries: {1st – 3 pts; 2nd – 2pts; 3rd – 1 pt.}); (2 entries: {1st – 2 pts; 2nd – 1 pt}).

Mini Rules:

1. Show is open to all miniature horses and show ponies. A division horses are under 34'' tall, B division horses are 34''-38'' tall, show ponies are 38''-48'' tall. We welcome everyone!
2. All horses must have negative coggins, within 12 months of show date. Copy must be shown at check in.
3. All participants must sign a liability wavier. Parent must sign wavier for those under 18 years of age.
4. Judge's decision is final. Classes may be combined or cancelled due to lack of entries.
5. In driving games classes and obstacle driving classes either a pleasure cart, roadster cart may be used.
6. Multiple driving teams welcome in all driving classes.
7. No stallions may be shown by any youth.
